



It is the adults who must place the repellents to children, to prevent them from handling the product.

- In case of spray or aerosol (in this case you must shake it previously), spray at a distance of 15 to 20 centimeters of skin and clothing, from side to side.
- If it is a cream, you should use your hands to spread it uniformly on the skin, remembering to also apply it on the ankle and elbow area.
- On the face, repellents should be applied carefully, placing them first in the palm of the hand to then apply the product on the face and behind the ears.

Totally avoid eye area and mouth, cuts, wounds, irritated skin or solar burnt skin.
